Hi there and thank you for booking a ticket for Wysing Polyphonic x Somerset House Studios.

Alongside four indoor stages there will be a covered bar area and various food providers including vegetarian and vegan options. **There are no cash withdrawal facilities at Wysing or anywhere nearby so please bear that in mind.**

If you arrive at Wysing by car, please park in the Main Car Park which is located in our Pond Field. Do not leave any valuables in your car.

If you are travelling to the festival using public transport, please be aware that the bus service ends in the early evening on Saturday and there are no buses on Sundays. If you need to organise a taxi, we recommend Panther Taxis on 01223 715715.

The sun always shines on the Wysing festival, but it would be worth bringing warm clothes for the evening. And due to the recent very dry weather, the ground around the site is cracked and uneven so please watch your footing and stick to the pathways wherever possible.

In terms of tickets, you can either print your ticket in advance which would speed up entry or bring ID and we will check your name off our lists when you get here. We will be searching all bags on arrival.
