RATIONALE

- This risk assessment has been compiled to protect people from real harm and suffering through practical steps, in line with the UK's Health & Safety Executive (HSE)
- The event plan seeks to balance the unachievable aim of absolute safety, and the kind of poor management of risk that damages lives.
- The event seeks to give young people autonomy and responsibility to explore their own creative interests, in an environment where risks are managed as much as possible.
- Covid-19 note: the risk around covid-19 is factored on the current/anticipated situation, as of September 2023.
- It is the responsibility of the person booking (parent/guardian/youth worker) to ensure they understand and agree to the plans put in place to minimise potential risks during the event at Wysing and undertake their own assessment of risk for the young person/people they intend on bringing to the event.
- Wysing Arts Centre has made this information available to support Group Leaders, Parents and Guardians to ensure the health and welfare of the young people they are booking places for. For Group Leaders, Parents and Guardians, Wysing can provide assistance in helping to identify any additional risks posed by any young people they are intending on bringing to the event.

- Wysing will be closed to the public, and staff will approach any lone adults
- Emergency contact info is provided for each young person attending (either on registration or held by group leader attending the event)
- Meeting point at reception for lost young people
- Individuals agree 'code of conduct' on sign up to event
- Designated staff on call during session to support potential incidents
- Site tours end before sunset
- If there is concern that someone has left the premises in suspicious circumstances, Senior Manager should be alerted immediately. The police should then be called. Parents/Carers should be informed immediately. A search of the site will take place.
- Roaming stewards identify any potential hazards and report to staff to mitigate risk as appropriate
- Young people attending through youth groups remain the responsibility of the associated youth group/leader. Any groups attending provide a minimum 1:12 adult to child ratio with at least 1 DBS checked staff member. If group deems the young person/people they are bringing pose an additional risk to themselves/others, then a higher adult:child ratio should be maintained by the group.

Child Protection officer to be informed immediately of any incidents to be followed up urgently. All incidents reported within 24 hour

All staff attending event are properly trained using the radios prior to event starting
